

KING HARBOR BOATER'S ADVISORY PANEL

'to preserve and promote boating in King Harbor'

The panel was formed at the request of the Mayor, at the inception of the *Heart of the City* process, to provide advice and recommendations on harbor and boating related issues. The panel includes representatives from the various constituent boating groups within the harbor and represents the interests of thousands of boating citizens.

The panel has identified the following issues as instrumental to preserving and promoting King Harbor's primary purpose of supporting recreational boating.

PANEL RECOMMENDATIONS

Public Launch Facility: as a Ramp adjacent to South Turning Basin and not on Mole B, consistent with the Guidelines of the California Department of Boating & Waterways

Bike Path: SAFE, no unregulated cross traffic, on mainland side of marina parking

Boating Facilities: enhance Outrigger Canoe and City Sailing Programs on Mole B

Small Boat Mast Up Dry Storage: coordinate with enhanced programs on Mole B

Guest Docking Facilities: provide adequate for visiting boaters to support harbor

Harbor Patrol: preserve boater safety with effective services & effective location

Boat Yard: maintain in King Harbor and preserve a safe and effective location

Harbor Expansion: Recommend Feasibility Study
