MINUTES OF MEETING

2/4/03

The meeting of the RBBA Executive Board was called to order by Dick Krebs at 7:08 PM

In attendance were: Dick Krebs, Bob Meistrell, Bill Paukert, Derek Tetlow, Bob Douglass., Michael Aaker, and Andy Davidson.

Items of action were as follows.

1. RBBA Website – Dick Krebs reported that Don Mueller had developed a website index that was now operational. In order to increase the awareness of the website it was agreed that it should be hyper-linked to the meeting minutes.
2. Boaters' information forums – Don Mueller is working with West Marine and Boaters World to get updated information for their seminars on the website
3. Heart of the City – Dick Krebs informed the group that Chris Cagle had been elected to the City Council and that another council election would be held in March for the third district seat.
4. Local sea condition advisory – Bob Douglass reported that he was looking for an answering machine that would keep only the latest messages and that members could call to receive the latest reports.
5. Technical Notes – Bob Douglass reported that he was able to convert his old technical information files to Word and this would facilitate getting them on the website (Don Mueller should get the files from Bob).
6. Legislative and regulatory issues – Dick Krebs reported that free oil/fuel absorbing bilge pads are available to boaters at Rocky Point fuel dock in Redondo Beach. They will also give you a free new pad for your old one
7. Updated slip roster – Updates are still being made.
8. Marina cleanup – It was confirmed that our insurance underwriter would not cover the Marina cleanup and may not renew our insurance policy. Alternative insurance coverage will be pursued. Bob Meistrell will contact his agent.
9. Bait Barge – It was reported that Chris Gerald is attempting to get the latest information on the bait barge operation and the contractual responsibilities.

10. Membership increase – Dick Krebs reported that each of the Marina operators will include an RBBA flyer and application in their next customer mailing. The mailers will be available by this weekend.

11. Dock Safety – Dick Krebs reported that he was receiving a positive response from the Marina operators relative to the RBBA letter on dock safety(letter requests life preserver throw rings on the docks). The proposal also received strong support from the Harbor Patrol.

12. New Business – Zeke Wheeler asked the status on membership renewals. Bill Paukert reported that renewals for over 120 members will be Due April 1st. Zeke also asked about the timing of the next newsletter. Derek Tetlow agreed to bring a draft to the next meeting
