**MINUTES OF MEETING**

**3/4/03**

**Call to Order:** Dick Krebs called the meeting of the RBBA Executive Board to order at 7:15 PM

**Attendees:** Dick Krebs, Bob Meistrell, Bill Paukert, Bob Douglass., Kevin Herink, Don Mueller, and Zeke Wheeler

**Action Items follows:**

1. **RBBA Website** – Don Mueller gave a 5 minute presentation showing board members the new website “site map” which improves access to all the various topics on website. He also has added pictures (many in colors) and descriptions on many of our local fish along with info on each fish’s max size, max weight, max lifespan, depth range to find them and lots of other useful info.
2. **Boaters' information forums** – Don Mueller is still working with West Marine and Boaters World to get updated information for their seminars on the website
3. **Heart of the City** – No significant action to report this month. Elections are being held today for District 3, Treasurer and two city measures.
4. **Local sea condition advisory** –Bob Douglas: No action this month.
5. **Boating Technical Articles** – Bob Douglass reported that he would provide Don Mueller before our next meeting some of his past issues of boating articles which he feels would be useful to put on our website for all our members to read.
6. **Legislative and Regulatory issues** – Don Mueller reported that he has posted on the website information relating to: Free oil/fuel absorbing bilge pads availability to boaters at Rocky Point fuel dock. Don Mueller and Bob Meistrell also reported that the Department of Fish and Game is so busy with security and safety issues that all matters relating to new regulations and restrictions are “on hold” for now and the foreseeable future.
7. **Updated slip roster** – Updates are still being made.
8. **Marina cleanup** – Bill Paukert is still trying to get us new insurance coverage, which will protect all our member activities including harbor cleanup. Kevin Herink will also see if he can get a quote on insurance that covers special one day events such as our Harbor Clean-up Day.
9. **Bait Barge** – No action this month.
10. **Membership increase** – Dick Krebs reported that all Marina operators were very cooperative at including our RBBA flyer and application with their monthly billing statement. Every boat owner of record in King Harbor should receive our mailing.
11. **Dock Safety** – Dick Krebs reported that each Marina has committed to study dock safety items for life-saving efforts. Harbor Patrol management strongly support this activity and will meet with each of the Harbor Operators to help implement. Our Board unanimously supports this safety action by the marinas and our Harbor Patrol. King Harbor is currently implementing throw rings on their docks.
12. **Membership Renewal:** Zeke Wheeler reminded board of April 1 dues renewal. Bill Paukert agreed to send notice to all members with email that their annual dues of \$25.00 is due April 1, 2003. Kevin will prepare a list and send notices to those members who do not have emails.
13. **Payment approvals:** The board authorized payment for two more trash barrels to be placed in the marina, to pay costs for stamps for mailings by King Harbor Marina and to pay for envelopes purchased .
14. **Meeting adjourned:** 8:30pm.
