MINUTES OF MEETING
6/05/03

Call to Order: Dick Krebs called the meeting of the RBBA Executive Board to order at 7:15 PM

Attendees: Dick Krebs, Bob Meistrell, Bill Paukert, Derek Tetlow, Darrel Ausherman and Chris Gerold, Don Mueller and Sue Morgan

Action Items follow:

1. **RBBA Website** – Pictures of life rings installations in King Harbor Marina have been added, along with links to newspaper articles on Lou Garcia's budget cut recommendations for the City.
2. **Boaters' information forums** – No action this month. Dick Krebs will contact West Marine for any updates.
3. **Heart of the City** – The newest plan is to simply downsize the density of the old Heart of the City plan and resubmit it to the City Council. There are many citizen groups ready to fight this with us.
4. **Local sea condition advisory** – No action this month.
5. **Boating Technical Articles** – No new action this month.
6. **Legislative and Regulatory issues** – Updates will be posted as they occur.
7. **Membership Renewal Status** – Bill Paukert reported that there are 105 non-renewals which are being contacted.
8. **Bait Barge** – Chris Gerold is still investigating to see if service can be improved. Currently, the barge is only open occasionally.
9. **Dock Safety** – Still waiting for other marinas to implement life rings, etc. They will be sent a notice that King Harbor Marina has installed theirs.
10. **Board Openings** – Graham Grice volunteered and was accepted as a Board Member by unanimous vote. Mike Morgan was also volunteered and accepted unanimously.
11. **City Council Issues** – Dredging Fees for Slipholders and Disbanding of Harbor Patrol: Dick Krebs and Derek Tetlow attended the 6/3/03 City Council Meeting and spoke strongly against both recommendations. Dick will request a history of harbor dredging from the Harbor Commission. The next Council meeting is 6/17.
12. **General Meeting**---The date has been set for 7/16/03. Detailed assignments for presentations, etc., will be made at the next Board Meeting.
13. **News letter**—It was reviewed for corrections. The corrected version will be mailed the week of 6/8/03.

New Business: Bob Meistrell has talked to Mayor Hahn about the problem of plastic in the water. This is a major issue for the Major and he was interested in the action the RBBA has

taken with installing trash barrels, etc. Bob will follow up by sending a letter and pictures to the Mayor.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:36.
