MINUTES OF MEETING

7/9/02

Attendees at the meeting were Dick Krebs, Bill Paukert, Bob Douglass, Derek Tetlow, Don Mueller, Darrell Ausherman, Bob Meistrell, Mike Morgan, Sue Morgan, and Angus Calder.

President Dick Krebs called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM and the following occurred:

1. The minutes of the 6/5/02 General Meeting were approved.

2. Action items from the general meeting were reviewed. These included:

a. Website: Don Mueller offered his wife Cathy's services in setting up the RBBA Website. Don volunteered help to maintain the sight along with Derek Tetlow's wife Cheryl. We will use Cathy's pre-existing domain for the present.

b. Initiating boaters information forums: RBBA will help promote meetings and forums being presented by Boat U.S., Boater's World, West Marine, etc. by putting them on the Website. The prospect of putting on our own forums occasionally will be investigated.

c. Track and work on Heart of the City issues in support of the King Harbor Advisory Panel: This is an ongoing process.

d. Local sea condition advisory: Southbaynet.com/pryc lists current conditions. Bob Douglass will look into more ways to provide up to the minute information, including live information from boaters underway. Fishing conditions could be added to the advisory.

e. Technical notes: These could be put on the Website. Bob Douglass has numerous articles of this nature which he wrote for Sea Magazine which he will volunteer. Bob Meistrell also has some ideas for this.

f. Legislative and regulatory issues will be followed by Angus Calder

g. Darrell Ausherman and Bob Meistrell will call to update the roster with slip, marina , and boat names. The updated roster may be used to map the target areas for new member solicitation With the members permission it could be given to all members so they can know other members.

h. Marina cleanup: The following suggestions were made -

- Talk to marina offices about having their workers dump the cans on a regular basis to keep odor down.
- Establish harbor cleanup weekends to get tenants involved.
- Hook up with the Sea Divers when they do their annual underwater cleanup

i. RBBA flyers also need to be updated. Krebs will do this.
