MINUTES OF MEETING
9/10/02

The 9/10/02 meeting of the RBBA Executive Board was called to order by Dick Krebs at 7:19 PM.

In attendance were: Sean Guthrie, Derek Tetlow, Don Mueller, Bill Paukert, Chris Gerold, Dick Krebs, Bob Meistrell, Mike Morgan, and Sue Morgan.

Minutes of the 8/6/02 meeting were approved.

Items of action were as follows.

1. RBBA Website - Don Mueller advised that the site was up, running, and basically finished. He and Cathy have added the ability to join and pay on-line. There is a members only section which requires a password and contains minutes from previous meetings, the by-laws, boating links, etc. The site will continue to grow and be updated.
2. Initiating boaters' information forums - There is nothing yet. Avenues are being researched and a volunteer to take charge is needed.
3. Heart of the City - Dick Krebs announced that there are several articles not addressed in the HOC referendum that are still active. Coastal land use has been sent to the Coastal Commission. Two community meetings are coming up and we need to decide how to address them. The City already has all the information on citizens' views from the first round of meetings, but seem to feel they need to hear it all again. The question is why? The City is rushing it through. We need to keep working with the Boaters' Advisory Council and also Chris Cagle's committee.
4. Local sea condition advisory - Bob Douglass is working on this, but was unable to attend tonight's meeting because he was making a presentation to King Harbor Yacht Club about the RBBA.
5. Technical notes update - They are in the process of trying to convert Bob Douglass' notes into a form that can be easily put on the Website.
6. Legislative and regulatory issues - No new updates from Angus Caller.
7. Updated slip roster - Still being worked on.
8. Marina cleanup - A letter was sent to all King Harbor marinas requesting employee help with the program. Redondo Beach Marina, which was not originally included, wants to join the program and install cans and skimmers. Very positive feedback was received from King Harbor, Port Royal and Portofino marinas. The Sea Divers canceled their fall cleanup due to lack of participation. RBBA will try to coordinate their own surface cleanup soon, and join with the Sea Divers when they do their next harbor cleanup sometime next summer.
9. RBBA Banners - Chris Gerold is getting banners made, 3' x 10' saying (1st line) "If You Care About Your Harbor (2nd line) Join Redondo Beach Boaters' Association (3rd line) Website address.
10. Harbor Commission appointees - Need to establish a better rapport with the Mayor and whoever appoints commission members, and strive to get appointees who are at least aware of boaters' concerns and interests.
11. New Business - Need to look into the bait barge situation. Frequently, bait is not available. Chris Gerold volunteered to research it.
